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3rd Sunday of Advent (Year B) – 13th December 2020

1st Reading – Isaiah 61:1-2a, 10-11 Psalm – My soul glorifies the Lord. 2nd Reading – 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24 Gospel – John 1:6-8, 19-28

Prophet Isaiah describes for us the role of the Spirit in our lives, the same Spirit we have received in the sacrament of baptism and confirmation. We have been anointed for a reason, essentially to bring the Lord to those who are most in need of Him. The Spirit is not just for me, the Spirit is given to me to be shared and passed on to others. We are called to be the good news, to soothe, to free, to release, and to comfort. It is the Lord who achieves all these things, and we are called to bear witness to what the Lord is doing.

To bear witness presumes we know what we are testifying about. If it is God, then we need to have spent time with God and listened to His voice speaking to us through the Scriptures, the Church, the Magisterium, other people, my own conscience, and my own experiences. Once I have listened to all these, then I can begin to bear witness. For St. Francis of Assisi, the primary way of bearing witness is to be a true follower of the poor and crucified Lord — words come later if necessary. St. Francis has very practical advice on what this all means in practice: do not engage in arguments or disputes, do not quarrel, grumble, or detract from others, nor judge or condemn. Instead, keep silence whenever God gives you the grace (Earlier Rule).

This list is not exhaustive, but illustrates the point that our life as a witness of the Lord is very radical and it affects our whole way of life. It goes to the very heart of who we are, people created in the image and likeness of God who are actually showing that likeness off or hiding it from others depending on the choices we make. We need to pray for the gift of the Spirit to lead us in the right direction, to appreciate and discover the truth of who we are, and to be able to bear witness to God by a life of faithfulness.

As part of our on-going journey of conversion this Advent, let us take up the example of St. Francis and pray for the grace of silence in order to show the image of a patient God to others. Be patient with yourself if you fail too many times.
