Bible Study - Our next session will be on Thursday 14 July, 7.30-8.30 p.m., in the Friary (NOT 7 July). Please read the passage beforehand and, if possible, have a look at the questions on the sheet.

Sea Sunday 10th July – There will be a 2nd collection on Sea Sunday 10th July. Seafarers and fishers play a vital role in all of our lives, but they often work in difficult, hazardous conditions. In the last year, more crews have been abandoned by their employers than ever before. Many are still being denied the right to leave their ships for even a short break from the relentless noise and pressure onboard. Many are reporting more stress and poorer mental health. On Sea Sunday the Church prays for all those who live and work at sea. Your support will make a big difference to seafarers and fishers in need. You can donate in church, by visiting
