Twenty Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time Year C – 25th September 2022

1st Reading – Amos 6:1, 4-7 Psalm – Praise the Lord, my soul! 2nd Reading – 1 Timothy 6:11-16 Gospel – Luke 16:19-31

Second collection this weekend is for the Father Hudson Society. Thank you for your generosity.

First Five Saturdays of Devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary – The Devotions will be held after the 8am mass. The First Devotion will be on Saturday 1^{st} October. Leaflets are available at the back of the church and a programme will be provided on the days.

Taizé will commence on <u>Thursday 29 September</u> in the Friary Chapel at 7.30 pm, for 1 hour. Taizé is a monastic community located in Taizé, France, founded in the 1940s. A Taizé worship service involves sung and chanted prayers, meditation, a period of silence, liturgical readings, and icons. Refreshments are provided afterwards and is an opportunity to build ecumenical friendship.

Training for altar servers – For all those who already serve as well as those who wish to serve, there will be training on <u>Saturday 1st October at 12noon</u>. Children should come along to the church with their parents.

Solemnity of St Francis is on <u>Tuesday 4th October</u> at 7pm. All are invited to join the friars for this Mass and refreshments in the hall afterwards.

Covid update: The priests have resumed distributing the Host on the tongue as well as on the hand and have also resumed sharing in the sign of peace.

Next weekend (1st and 2nd October) The Good Shepherd Company from the Holy land (Bethlehem) which is based in Nottingham will be selling olive wood carvings to support and help the Christian families in the Holy land to stay at work. Olive wood carving is one of the most important sources of income for them. 90% of the Christians rely on this sale. By selling their produce here this will prevent the Christians from leaving the country in search of better work opportunities, a survey from the bishops of Jerusalem found there is only forty one thousand Christians left in the area.
