Psalm – Let us see, O Lord, your mercy and give us your saving help.

2nd Reading – St. Peter 3:8-14

Gospel – Mark 1:1-8

PLENARY INDULGENCE IN FRANCISCAN CHURCHES:

From the 8th December till 2nd February, the faithful who visit a Franciscan church in order to stop and pray in front of the nativity scene can receive a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (be in a state of grace, pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, receive the Lord in the Eucharist). Likewise, those who are sick or unable to participate physically can equally benefit from the gift of plenary indulgence, offering their sufferings to the Lord or carrying out practices of piety. 'An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints.' (Catechism of the Catholic Church n1471)

This gift and privilege granted to all our Franciscan churches throughout the world by our Holy Father is to mark the occasion of the 800th anniversary of Christmas in Greccio, where St. Francis of Assisi wanted to commemorate the birth of the Lord starting with a nativity scene leading to the Eucharistic celebration, where Jesus Christ makes himself present in the bread and wine.

Our church will be open from **5.30pm - 6.30pm on Monday 11th, Thursday 14th, Monday 18th, Thursday 21st** for prayer of the rosary, evening prayer and silent meditation. Extra times will be announced in the New Year.

A Service of Lessons and Carols by candlelight, sung by Greyfriars Choir at 3pm on Sunday 17th December in Greyfriars Church, followed by mulled wine and mince pies in the Parish Hall. Please come along and enjoy a very festive afternoon!
