# Thirty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year A) 19<sup>th</sup> November 2023

1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Proverbs 31:10-13,19-20,30-31 Psalm – Oh blessed are those who fear the Lord. 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Thessalonians 5:1-6 Gospel – Matthew 25:14-30

**Second collection for World Youth Sunday** will be next weekend, <u>Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> November</u>, Feast of Christ the King, a day on which Pope Francis invites the global Church to celebrate and pray for young people. In Lisbon this year, Pope Francis told young people that "Jesus' door is always open: Come and See!"
