First Sunday of Advent – 27th November 2022

1st Reading – Isaiah 2:1-5 Psalm – I rejoiced when I heard them say: 'Let us go to God's house'. 2nd Reading – Romans 13:11-14 Gospel – Matthew 24:37-44

1st Friday Devotions – This coming Friday we will have our usual Mass for the intentions of the sick at 3.30 p.m. Afterwards there is a chance to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick and honour the Sacred Heart of the Lord who is always with us in the Blessed Sacrament.
