The Baptism of the Lord – 8th January 2023 1st Reading – Isaiah 42:1-4,6-7 Psalm – The Lord will bless his people with peace. 2nd Reading – Acts of the Apostles – 10:34-38 Gospel – Matthew 3:13-17

This Sunday brings Christmastime to a close and we return to the Ordinary Time within the Church's liturgical year. There is nothing ordinary about our daily life since God chose to dwell in our midst and make His home within us. Through Jesus' birth every moment and every part of our daily routine has been sanctified and we are called to recognize the Lord who is with us. There are many blocks along the way that prevent us from seeing this truth and that cloud our judgment. One great way of learning what it means to follow the Lord's Gospel message is to apply it as best we can. Today we hear a simple message: You are my beloved, my favour rests on you. Some of us may hear these words with great difficulty and would like to brush over them quickly and not pay too much attention. It may be because we feel unworthy or that we are very focused on our own sins and weaknesses or the things we get wrong. It may take a long time and many repetitions before the truth of those words sinks in. God loves me deeply. If that isn't tough enough, we then need to apply the same words to those we live with. Underneath everything that is visible and that we notice about the other - how well do we remember that the same words God speaks to us are also directed to those around us? How many times can we catch ourselves out and have to admit that this truth escapes us so easily and far too quickly? Let's take time this week and sit with those words for a bit longer: You are my beloved.
